OUR PURPOSE

We are a supportive transitional housing ministry that bridges the gap between homelessness and permanent housing for single mother families in and around Cherokee County.

To create safe, stable, God-Centered homes for single moms and their children to rebuild, grow, and begin to dream again.

To restore, renew, and refresh single mother families through a Christ-Centered program that values each family and brings glory to God. To build relationships with and educate the community to care for families in need.

OUR PROGRAM

Is designed to assist single women with children to achieve family stability. We believe this includes: permanent housing, financial stability through employment and good stewardship, life changing friendships, increased self-esteem and personal growth.

3 Key areas we serve single moms



Family Advocacy

Each mom in our program receives personal, individualized weekly coaching in 6 key areas: career, finances, health, time management, relationships, and spiritual growth.



Community

Our community approach is built on mentoring teams for every single mom in our program. These relationships allow her to build a safe network of friendships for herself and her children. Her mentor team supports her with the goal to restore her to strong healthy relationships.



Housing and Financial **Assistance**

Bridging the gap between homelessness and financial stability allows a single mom to seek career building support and resources over two years.

By providing housing, coaching, Christ-centered community, mentoring, financial assistance, and budgeting classes, we offer single moms foundational tools to build their future.


